

## Blended class CPR/first aid, AED requirements

AHA allows certificated BLENDED CPR classes in which the students take the bulk of the training online, but to receive the 2-year certificate, they must participate in a “hands-on” evaluation. The evaluation is primarily focused on CPR and AED which takes about 30-40 minutes per session. This class will not certify Nurses or anyone needing Basic Life Support for Professionals.

**SIPE offers this training at NO COST to its member districts.**

To schedule a class, send [sipe@sbceo.org](mailto:sipe@sbceo.org) the following:

- Name and current email of employee (should be a district email) once sipe receives the names of participants, we set up the online class. Each individual will be emailed their own personal link to the class. Please note that participants should **NOT** share the link as the link is personalized to the individual that receives the link. IF a person doesn't get the link, have them check their spam/junk mail folder first. If they still cannot find the link, contact Keith ([kcox@sbceo.org](mailto:kcox@sbceo.org)) or Maria Segrero ([msegrero@sbceo.org](mailto:msegrero@sbceo.org)) and we will resend the link. **Do not** have other participants share their link as they are personalized to that person.
- After taking the online CPR class, participants will be prompted to print out the successful completion certificate. Everyone must print out and bring the certificate of completion to the hands-on evaluation session in order to get certified.
- Everyone must participate in the hands-on evaluation and **be physically capable of performing CPR**. We do not allow CPR to be performed on a chair or a table. Anyone not physically capable should not take the class.
- SIPE pays for CPR classes, however if anyone you sign up doesn't show up to the hands-on evaluation class, SIPE will charge your district. SIPE will give you the opportunity to have a make-up class, but it has to be within one month, otherwise, SIPE will charge for those that do not do hands-on evaluation.
- If districts have multiple hands-on classes in one day, participants **MUST** arrive on time. Once the class starts, they cannot join late.
