I. CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME BY CHAIRPERSON

Keith Cox, Loss Control Director, called the meeting to order at 10:08 a.m.

III. PUBLIC COMMENTS

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

V. <u>MISHAP SUMMARIES</u>

Mr. Cox presented claims for FY 2022-23 totaling 499, claims for FY 2023-24 totaling 490 to date. He also displayed top ten claims by occupation for FY 2023-24 to date and top ten injury cause/cost for FY 2023-24. The Committee reviewed and discussed bringing forward more information on slips, trips and falls at a future meeting.

A. APPROVAL OF 2024-25 MEETING DATES

B. DISCUSSION: NEW EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROGRAM

Dennis Thomas, SBCEO School Safety Liaison, spoke on the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) that has been adopted by Santa Barbara County.

VIII. OPEN DISCUSSION/DISTRICT CONCERNS

Reese Thompson, Santa Maria Joint Union School District initiated a discussion regarding ideas for using remaining Safety Incentive Funds from the 2023-24 program year, including a possible group purchase of safety shoes to prevent slip, trips, and falls for the JPA. The Committee agreed to begin by drilling down on high frequency and severity incidents, then to consider further the use of funds for a specific pool-wide safety purchase.
